## DO YOU QUALIFY FOR THE NEED-BASED FUND?

Project Everlast's budget makes it impossible to give money to everyone who requests it. In fact, we've had to tighten our qualification standards recently. So even if you were able to get Need-Based Funds in the past, it doesn't necessarily mean you'll be approved this time. If you answer yes to BOTH of these questions you are eligible for the grant.

- Do you need money for an emergency?
- Are you unable to get what you need from another resource (for example, if you need to buy groceries, you can go to a food pantry.)

## **STILL THINK YOU QUALIFY?**

Complete the form and submit to Lindsey. If you don't provide all of the requested information, you may not qualify. Once submitted, the application takes 10 to 14 days to process as long as the application is completely filled out.

If we do approve your request, Lindsey will work with you to help you pay for the service or item you need. Check will not be written directly to you. In addition, Lindsey is very knowledgeable about services in our community and may be able to connect you to resources that can provide what you need at little or no cost.
